Frequently Asked Questions

Who chooses the award recipients?

Recipients are selected by a group of volunteer community leaders. ***Should I tell the volunteers they've been nominated?*** Yes! It is a great honor to be nominated for a United Way Community Volunteer Award.

What happens after a volunteer is nominated?

After the nomination form is received at the United Way Volunteer Center, a congratulatory letter will be sent to the nominee. Later, the nominee will receive an invitation to the awards luncheon on April 26, as a guest of United Way of Dane County and event sponsors.

Can I submit more than one nomination?

Yes, as long as the nominees do not perform the same function within the same organization.

Are only volunteers at United Way partner agencies eligible?

Volunteers at ANY nonprofit organization in Dane County can be nominated as long as they meet eligibility requirements to the left.

I don't have a photo. What do I do?

You will be notified of dates that the nominee can come to United Way to have their photo taken.
