Responsibilities are flexible, and we encourage creativity to shape this role and its responsibilities to align with your workplace culture.

Responsibilities* Time Commitment Communicate with members/donors in your workplace 1-3 hours annually Thank and celebrate staff by demonstrating impact of their collective giving 1-6 hours annually or plan workplace engagement (e.g., luncheon, volunteer activity/social) Work closely with Campaign Team to plan and strategize campaign; promote 1-6 hours during workplace activities and programs during annual campaign campaign Meet other members/volunteers for latest updates and networking 1-4 hours annually opportunities *Dependent on leadership support and work culture. Responsibilities are flexible from low to high commitment, and all communications/events are supported by United Way of Dane County. Engagement can be conducted through targeted

communications with known members or broad communications with all staff (if member/donor identity is unknown).

Lead United Ambassador

Represent leadership giving in your workplace, and ensure all members are recognized for their impact and invited to Lead United activities.

Responsibilities may include:

- Share latest Lead United news and impact with your Lead United members
- Promote Lead United events, volunteer opportunities and socials with your members
- Send targeted communications to Lead United members and Step-Up prospects (e.g., thanking them when they give, connecting their gift to their impact, educating them on programs and needs)
- Explore collaboration opportunities with Tocqueville members and workplace leadership to incentivize and celebrate leadership giving via a luncheon, workplace engagement or recognition party
- Work closely with Campaign Team/Employee Campaign Managers to promote Lead United/Step-Up during campaign
- Join Lead United Council (volunteer leadership) and attend monthly meetings (optional)

Represent Women United membership at your workplace, and ensure all members are recognized for their advocacy and invited to Women United activities.

Responsibilities may include:

- Recruit and support Women United members
- Participate in and promote Women United volunteer engagements and special events
- Explore collaboration between your Women's Employee Resources Group (ERG) with *Women United at Work*, an ERG network designed to engage your members and exchange ERG resources!
- Join Women United Council and attend monthly meetings (optional)

LINC Ambassador

Represents LINC membership at your workplace, and ensure all members are recognized for their impact and invited to LINC activities.

Responsibilities may include:

- Share latest LINC news, events and updates within your organization
- Participate in and promote volunteerism and workplace engagement
- Welcome new employees by inviting them to LINC activities
- Recruit and support LINC members
- Join LINC Council and attend monthly meetings (optional)
