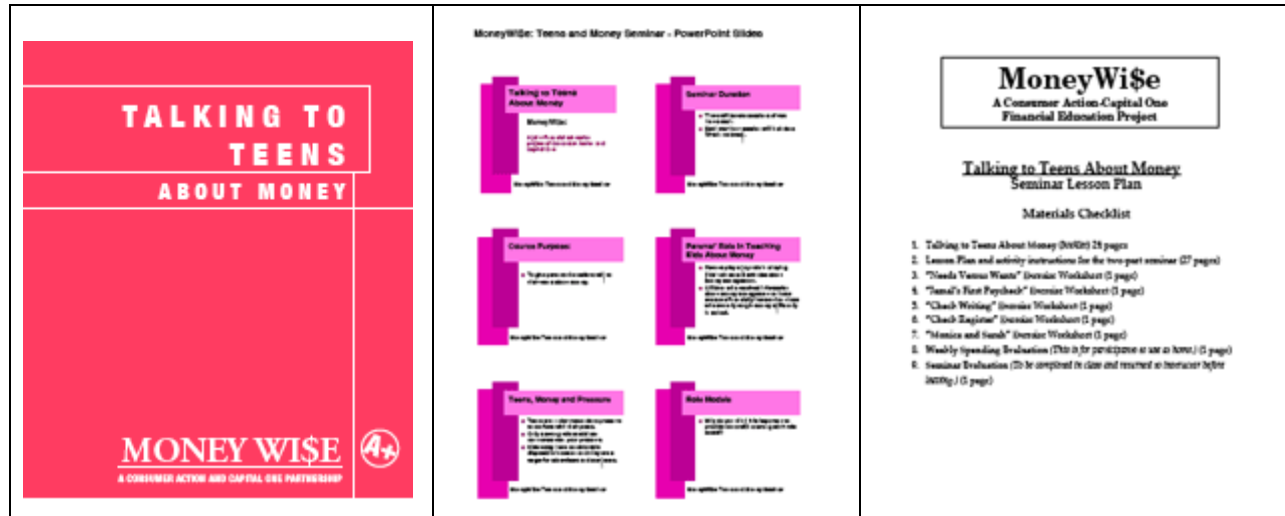


Teens and Money
