### ***Case Management - Porchlight***

Assists formerly homeless persons with Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse and/or mental health issues to maintain permanent, stable housing through comprehensive case management.

**DIGS**

Reduces and prevents homelessness by providing short-term emergency financial assistance and coordination with relevant community resources, including assistance with utility bills and other emergency housing needs.

**Housing First Sun Prairie**

Provides safe and affordable permanent housing with supportive case management for very low and low-income families in Sun Prairie.

**Housing Operations**

Provides safe and affordable transitional and permanent housing with supportive case management for very low and low-income homeless individuals and families. Serves many who were formerly homeless and seeks to move persons from the transitional housing units, which have a time limit of two years, to stable and independent permanent housing.

**Stoughton Area Resource Team (START), Inc.**

Links Stoughton School District families and individuals under 55 with community resources and provides case management support in housing, health, and employment and financial assistance.

**Comprehensive Community Services**

Addresses the mental health and substance abuse needs of families transitioning from homelessness in a more holistic way so they can remain in housing.

**Housing and Hope**

The Housing and Hope initiative is based on best practices including scattered site housing, quality case management, and public/private partnerships to create of affordable, supported-housing for homeless families. The Road Home provides homeless families participating in this initiative intensive, long-term case management to assist them in reaching stability.

**Housing Stabilization**

Provides daily case management to families in order to help them attain permanent housing, stable income and access to other needed services such as child care, legal services and education.

**The Salvation Army of Dane County**

Serves as the single point of access into the public-funded shelter system for all homeless families in Dane County, helping to transition to permanent housing.

**House-ability**

Collaborative effort of The Road Home, the Salvation Army, and the YWCA Madison that provides permanent housing, with rent subsidies and case management services, to 23 homeless families with a disabled adult.

***Housing Counseling***

Provides case management to help families living in shelter find affordable housing, while helping them overcome barriers that caused them to become homeless.

***Resident Housing First***

Provides on-site long-term housing and support services to low-income women living in the YWCA's E. Mifflin St. building.

***Second Chance Apt Project and Permanent Housing***

Matches 15 homeless families with congregations that will sign leases with landlords and pay rent for up to two years for the families. Congregations will assign mentors to families for social support and encouragement.

***Third Street***

Provides up to two years of on-site housing and personalized support services to homeless mothers with children under four years of age. The goal of this program is to help these mothers learn healthy parenting skills and eventually become self-sufficient in their community.

***Tree Lane***

Supported housing that provides behavioral health treatment and services for substance use disorders and co-occurring mental health disorders, and other critical services for families experiencing homelessness.
