

If your organization has previously used e-CImpact to apply for FEMA EFSP funds, you will find a link to the application on your homepage, under the “Apply/Report” section of the left-hand sidebar.

If you are a current United Way of Dane County partner agency, and this is your first time applying for FEMA EFSP funds, complete the following steps to access the Phase 40 application:

Step 1: Under the “Apply/Report” section of the left-hand sidebar, select “Request a Grant Application.”

Step 2: Select the check box for “FEMA EFSP Phase 40,” then click “Continue.”

Registering a New Agency

If you have not completed an application in this portal before and are not a current United Way of Dane County Partner Agency, please proceed with site registration. Registration is required for all applicants not already in the system. If you are unsure whether you need to create a new account, please contact Breanna Grow at Breanna.Grow@uwdc.org.

Step 1: From the agency login page, click “Click here to create a new e-CImpact account.”

Step 2: Please enter your EIN. The system will automatically validate your EIN, confirming you do not already have an e-CImpact account. The system will also automatically enter any information linked to the EIN entered. Once you have entered your EIN, click “Next.”

Step 3: Please enter all required agency information. Review all agency information entered, and then click “Confirm Registration.” Once your registration is completed you may print your confirmation page. You will also receive a confirmation email.

Step 4: After entering all required, proceed to the next page. You’ve arrived at your agency homepage. On the bottom left under Apply/Report, select “Request a Grant Application.”

Step 5: Select the check box for “FEMA EFSP Phase 40,” then click “Continue.”
